Health guidelines:

In accordance with the latest COVID public health order by the State of California Department of Public Health (CDPH) that went into effect on June 15, 2021 ([here](#)), we are now following county guidelines as we meet together during 2021 season.

- **There are no longer distancing or capacity limits**
- **Face masks are not required to be worn by vaccinated individuals but vaccination status will not be verified or enforced**
- **Participants will be made to feel comfortable if they choose to wear face masks for any reason, regardless of vaccination status**
- **Non-vaccinated individuals are strongly encouraged to wear a mask**

The CDPH will continue to monitor scientific evidence and will amend their guidance as needed, so our plans will be fluid as public policy changes.
